



## Thailand 5-Day Tour – Bangkok and Pattaya (CITTL1)

### Day 1: Arrival in Bangkok

Today you will arrive at Bangkok International Airport. Your tour guide will meet you at the airport and escort you to your hotel for rest and leisure time.

### Day 2: Bangkok – Pattaya (B/L/D)

After breakfast in your hotel, you will check out and begin your tour of Bangkok. First, you will visit the **Golden Buddha Temple**, then drive through Chinatown and past the Democracy Monument and Parliament House. Finally, you will arrive at the **Grand Palace**, a large compound containing many ornate buildings with a wide variety of architectural styles, including the half-Gothic, half-Thai **Reception Hall**, the **Funeral Hall**, the **Coronation Hall**, and the **Chapel Royal**, which houses the famous **Emerald Buddha**. For lunch, you will have a mixed buffet of Thai and international food. Afterward, you will visit the **Snake Farm** and then proceed to **Pattaya Beach Resort**. Dinner will be served in your hotel, after which you will take in the world-class **Alcazar Cabaret Show**.

### Day 3: Pattaya (B/L/D)

Today, you will take a speedboat to **Coral Island**. There you can either go for a relaxing swim in the clear blue sea or participate in all kind of optional activities, such as parasailing, “sea walking” (walking on the ocean floor using a special device), riding a water scooter, riding on a banana boat, etc. Local seafood barbecue will be served on the island for lunch. In the afternoon, you will first return to the hotel to shower and change clothes, and then you will enjoy a relaxing **Thai-style massage**. Afterward, you will proceed to the **Floating Market**, where you can see the traditional open-front Thai native houses that line the river. In the evening, you will have a buffet dinner at the **Alangkarn Restaurant** and then see the **Alangkarn Cultural Show**, a Las Vegas-style extravaganza featuring over 150 performers.

### Day 4: Pattaya – Bangkok (B/L/D)

After breakfast at your hotel, you will begin your return trip to Bangkok. On the way, you will stop at the **Siam Elephant Garden**, where you can take an elephant ride, and at the **World Gems Museum**. After lunch, you will arrive in Bangkok and check into your hotel. Afterward, you will take a tour of the modern section of Bangkok and see the famous **Four-Faced Buddha**, actually a statue of the Hindu god Brahma. For your farewell dinner, we have made special arrangements for you to try some **Thai Sukiyaki** (hot pot).

### Day 5: Bangkok – U.S.A. (B)

After breakfast, your tour guide will escort you to Bangkok International Airport for your flight back home.
